Last Month recorded crime;

Burglary Dwelling. X 4

03/04/2018 Finkle Lane. Daytime offence. Suspects smash rear French doors of property and gain entry. Once inside electrical goods stolen. Filed as no further lines of enquiry.

04/04/2018 Hawthorne Close. Daytime offence. Smash rear window to gain entry. Stolen jewellery. Filed as no further lines of enquiry.

29/04/2018. Woodhead Lane. Daytime offence. Smash window before being disturbed by occupant. 1 Male arrested on suspicion of this offence, was released after investigation as there were evidential difficulties. The victim could not identify the suspect.

04/05/2018. Town End. Overnight offence. Suspects snap Euro profile lock. Gain entry and take handbags and personal items before being disturbed by the occupants and making off. Some property located in the Birkenshaw area. Enquiries still ongoing,.
