

**LEEDS CITY COUNCIL
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (MOVEMENT RESTRICTION)
(NO.M06) ORDER 2019**

GILDERSOME VILLAGE

7.5 TONNE MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT LIMIT (EXCEPT FOR ACCESS)

Leeds City Council proposes to make the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit Heavy Commercial Vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight (except for access) from proceeding on the whole lengths of:-

Ashwood Drive; Ashwood Gardens; Ashwood Grove;

Birchfield Avenue; Branch End; Briarfield Gardens;

Church Avenue; Church Gardens; Church Gate; Church Street; College Road;

Deanhurst Gardens;

Finkle Court; Finkle Lane; Flossmore Way; Forest Bank;

Gildersome Lane; Graham Walk; Greenfield Avenue; Greenfield Drive; Greenside Court;

Harthill; Harthill Avenue; Harthill Close; Harthill Lane; Harthill Paddock; Harthill Parade; Harthill Rise;

Hawthorne Close; Hawthorne Drive; Hawthorne View; Highfield Close; Highfield Drive; Highfield Gardens;

Highfield View;

Kenilworth Avenue; Kenilworth Gardens;

Mill Croft; Mill Garth; Mill Lane; Moorfield; Moorland Avenue; Moorland Close; Moorland Crescent;

New Lane;

Park Crescent; Park Grove; Parkway;

Reedsdale Avenue; Reedsdale Drive; Reedsdale Gardens;

Scott Green; Scott Green Crescent; Scott Green Drive; Scott Green Grove; Scott Green Mount; Scott

Green View; Spring Avenue; Spring View; Springbank Avenue; Springbank Crescent; Springbank Road;

Street Lane; Suffield Close; Suffield Crescent; Suffield Drive; Suffield Road; Sunrise Court;

The Nooks; Town End; Town Street; Turton Green; Turton Vale;

Valley Court; Vicarage Avenue;

West End and Woodhead Lane.
